Advise and guide pupils and parents on instrumental education

Undertake development of the music curriculum as it relates to instrumental education

Contribute to and support the activities of the Instrumental Music Service

Prepare lessons and courses in instrumental music

Assess, record and report on the work of instrumental pupils

Help organise and participate in school ensemble and musical activity programmes

Work co-operatively as part of a team

Ensure that instruments are maintained in an acceptable condition as appropriate

Maintain good order and discipline and safeguard health and safety amongst pupils and colleagues

Foster relationships with external musical agencies and partner organisations

Contribute to city wide musical activities and participate fully in the musical life of school communities.
